Reeds virtuoso Andy Firth has performed with some of the world's finest jazz acts and ensembles. In 2008, Andy was invited to play a concert under his own name at the famed Recital Hall in Carnegie Hall, New York, with guest artist, US clarinet legend, Buddy DeFranco.

Andy is a published composer and arranger with Boosey & Hawkes London, Trinity College London, Reed Music Australia, Alfred Music and AMEB Publications. He has been awarded an Australian film and television award, MO award for best live jazz performer in Australia, South Australian Jazz Archives Award and an Australia Day Honours award for his services to music in Australia.

In 2000, US mouthpiece maker Lomax Classic, further honored Andy with his own series of clarinet mouthpieces, the "Andy Firth Jazz Series". Andy is also the Australian artist

for Buffet Crampon clarinets, D'Addrio Reeds, Julius Keilwerth Saxophones and Lomax Classic Mouthpieces.

Andy continues to tour and perform with Australia's leading jazz and classical artists and ensembles and he is a regular guest performer at national and international clarinet and saxophone conferences both in Australia and overseas.
